# Summer Camp

Active Christian Teen Camp (Maranatha) and Pleasant Island Youth Camp (Mt. Pleasant) operate together to provide the very best camp experience.

Our program is designed to meet the needs of children and teens physically, socially and most importantly, spiritually. Every camper is actively involved with sports, skits, games, Bible study, new friendships and "boatloads" of FUN! Our schedule is packed full of activities, such as canoeing, swimming, softball, volleyball, basketball, and flag football. Then there are the unique games that you only get to play at camp. You will laugh yourself silly at the games, skits, gags, and stunts. Excellent food is served at each meal. Enriching activities include: interesting classes, cabin devotions, music, Bible memory, camp fire, and morning chapel. Each day wraps up with a great preaching service. The week of Junior camp will be held at The historic Pleasant Island facility in Elkview. Teen camp will be held at Camp Sheppard, the 4H facility in Roane County.



## DRESS STANDARDS:

All clothing must be loose fitting and cover the body from shoulders to the middle of the knee. For recreation - girls and boys may wear loose fitting sports clothes that come to the middle of the knee. For preaching services - boys will wear shirts with collars - girls will wear a skirt or dress. Campers must remove body piercing except girls with pierced ears. The camp reserves the right to require any camper to change their clothing if it is deemed inappropriate.

## WHAT TO BRING:

Bible, notepad, pencil, bed linens, pillow, warm sweater or jacket, toilet articles, swimsuit (one piece for girls), ball glove, water bottle, sports clothes for activities, dress clothes for evening service, spending money for snack shop, and large bag for dirty clothes. Please label all belongings. Girls, don't forget skirts or dresses for the services.

## DO NOT BRING:

Any type of electronic device including (but not limited to) cell phone, CD/DVD/mp3 or other music/media devices, computers, PDAs, radios, TVs, video games, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, guns, knives, magazines, T-shirts with worldly advertising, immodest clothing, bad language or an unChrist-like attitude.



## PARENTS NOTES:

- 1) Campers are expected to stay the entire week except for sickness or emergency.
- 2) We have an extremely full schedule which is difficult to interrupt for phone calls or visits.
- 3) Campers are not permitted to use the phone except in emergencies.
- 4) A reservation fee of \$25.00 must be submitted with registration and medical form. *The reservation fee is NOT refundable.*

## CAMPERS HEALTH & SAFETY:

Our camp is committed to the health and safety of each camper. Qualified lifeguards and medically trained personnel are present. The camp medications nurse will collect and dispense ALL medicine including prescription and over-the-counter medications. Any activity restrictions, health concerns, dietary needs or behavioral considerations can be noted on the Health Information statement. We welcome any information you (parent/guardian) feel is important to the well-being of your child. If your child is on a special diet they must bring their own food.

## LICE:

All campers will be checked for head lice at registration. Campers must be nit-free in order to participate in camp.

## COST:

## ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE:

Registration is 10:30 am to 11:30 am on Monday. The camp program begins at 12 noon. Registration will not be open prior to 10:30 am. Camp ends at 9 am on Saturday for Teen Week and 9 am on Friday for Junior Week. The preaching services and teaching classes are for campers and are NOT open to the public.

## CHRISTIAN CONDUCT:

Our camp maintains high standards of Christian conduct. Separate swim times are scheduled for boys and girls. The camp reserves the right to set standards of conduct such as boy/girl relations, dress standards, response to authority, etc. Campers who violate these standards are subject to dismissal at parents' expense.
